Multi-Systemic Therapy (MST) Success Story

MST serviced a female youth struggling with low self-confidence along with verbal and physical aggression at school, which affected her relationship with her sibling and reputation with peers and school personnel. MST anchored on Mom's strengths of willingness to learn, high follow through, and her ability to always be positive and strength focused. Throughout treatment this youth learned how to understand sequences, to activate coping skills when needed, and started to recognize her own self-worth. Today, this youth has returned to a non-alternative high school where she is well-liked by peers and staff, active in school events, and has set a goal to graduate. According to Mom, their family had the best summer in many years because of the changes in their home. This youth has been successfully released from probation!

ACS/PDFRP Success Story

It is always inspiring to see a youth turn their life around and grow closer to their family. The success of this large family was due to the changes the family was able to implement to ensure that the youth and community were safe. Initially, the caretaker had difficulty recognizing how much of a support she was to her family and the impact she had on her children. Mom felt she had tried everything to keep the youth from getting into trouble and that he was nearly an adult compared to her other children. Over time, however, she became extremely proactive and we were able to leverage the positive attitude she exhibited from the start. There was great improvement between Mom and son, as well as in family functioning. Tears were shed when the family was closed out, but Mom is always excited to share their continuing progress at follow-ups. What a success!
